



## Student Code of Conduct

**STSYR010**

Revised: Jan. 2013

Students are responsible to the principal for their conduct on the bus, and must obey instructions from the driver who acts on behalf of the principal.

Student conduct that endangers safety or interferes with the health of others may face school disciplinary action and/or have their transportation privilege revoked.

*While riding a school vehicle Students shall:*

1. be at the bus stop at least 5 minutes in advance of the scheduled pick-up time; 10 minutes earlier for the first two weeks of school.
2. refrain from talking to the bus driver while bus in in motion except in cases of emergency
3. refrain from making loud noises, fighting, and the use of abusive or profane language.
4. refrain from eating, drinking, or littering inside/outside the bus.
5. not smoke, use drugs, or alcohol.
6. remain seated at all times.
7. keep all body parts inside the bus at all times.
8. keep their backpacks, books and parcels on their laps.
9. recognize that due to safety concerns, items that do not fit safely on a student's lap (ie. sports equipment, musical instruments and science projects) **may not** be transported to and from school.
10. bring skates on the bus only if equipped with protective guards and are carried in a sports bag.
11. follow recommended Ministry of Transportation safety procedures when crossing the roadway, and loading and unloading the bus.
12. be responsible for any willful damage to the bus and at a designated bus stop.
